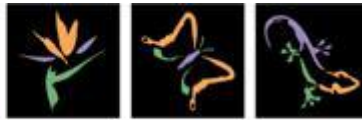

1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

1. Background

SANBI seeks to appoint a service provider to supply building materials at the Lowveld National Botanical Garden (Lowveld NBG) campus for a period of three (3) years. The service providers will be appointed under this contract on a quotation basis when the supply of garden tools is required.

The purpose of this Request for Quotation (RFQ) is to invite prospective Service Providers to submit quotations for supplying the Lowveld National Botanical Garden with building materials for the period of three (3) years. Potential Service Providers who have experience in supplying quality building materials or equivalent are invited to submit quotations. The service provider is expected to indicate the cost of building materials prescribed below.

2. Invitation to Quote

Quotations are invited from service providers to supply Garden Tools to the Lowveld LN BG campus for a period of three (3) years.

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3. Scope of Work

- Supply of building materials (e.g. cement, sand, aggregate, paving and building bricks, roof tiles, etc.)

Requirements:

- The service provider must have a reliable and efficient logistics system
- The service provider must be able to provide materials at competitive prices

4. Contract Period:

The contract will be for a period of three years.

5. Delivery:

Materials must be delivered to Lowveld NBG premises within 72 hours of receipt of purchase order.

6. Payment:

Payment will be made within 60 days of receipt of invoice.

7. Warranty:

The service provider must guarantee the quality of materials for a period of six months from delivery.

8. REQUIREMENTS FOR PROPOSALS

8.1 Mandatory documents required.
